

NARRATIVE

On November 12, 2023 at approximately 1036 hours, I was dispatched to a hit and run collision that occurred approximately 30 minutes ago, at the Grand Forest West parking lot located at 9752 Miller Rd on Bainbridge Island, Wa.

I called the victim, [REDACTED], who told me he parked his black, 2019 Subaru Outback bearing WA license plate # [REDACTED] on the South side of the parking lot, packed into a middle space. [REDACTED] said he went out for a run, and when he came back, there was a yellow sticky note on his windshield that said, "A green Subaru Outback hit your front right side and left. Tried to stop them Plate # [REDACTED]. Sorry!"

I ran the license plate which came back to a green, 2012 Subaru Outback. The registered owner is not from the area, and we were unable to obtain any contact information.

[REDACTED]'s vehicle sustained minor damage to the front, passenger side of the vehicle.

It is unknown who was driving the running vehicle and there is no surveillance footage. The person that left the note on the vehicle did not leave any contact information so there are no known witnesses.
