

Unit 1 was travelling Eastbound on Wyatt Way NW and came to the intersection of Wyatt Way NW and Grow Ave where there was a 4-Way Stop. Unit 1 came to a complete stop at the stop sign.

The juvenile pedalcyclist was travelling Southbound on Grow Ave when they came to the 4-Way stop intersection of Wyatt Way NW and Grow Ave. The juvenile pedalcyclist was riding a black/blue "Lectric" electric bicycle. According to the pedalcyclist, they stopped at the stop sign and observed a vehicle stopped travelling Northbound on Grow Ave. The juvenile said they waited their turn at the stop sign, and continued Southbound on Grow Ave. The juvenile said they saw Unit 1 pull up to the stop sign, stop, then collide with them.

According to the driver of Unit 1, they saw the pedalcyclist rolling from the North side of the intersection, Southbound, but they never saw the pedalcyclist come to a complete stop. The driver of Unit 1 looked to the right and observed a vehicle turning from Grow Ave to Wyatt Way. Unit 1 said they were distracted by the vehicle to the right of them and did not look left before continuing forward. Unit 1 continued through the stop sign on Wyatt Way and made impact with the pedalcyclist.

There were two witnesses to this collision. Both witnesses claimed they observed Unit 1 travelling Northbound on Grow Ave. Neither witness saw the pedalcyclist riding the bicycle.

Based on the damage to Unit 1 and the bicycle and the stories from both Unit 1 and the juvenile pedalcyclist, the collision occurred the way the two parties involved explained.

Unit 1 sustained minor damage to the front end of the vehicle.

The pedalcyclist sustained minor injuries, scrapes to the legs and a chipped front tooth. Due to the chipped front tooth, the juvenile pedalcyclist and their father decided to take the ferry and get checked at Seattle Children's Hospital.
