

NARRATIVE

Driver of Unit 1 was backing out of a parking space located at the Town & Country store, 343 Winslow Way, on Bainbridge Island, WA.

According to witness and owner of Unit 3, the driver of Unit 1 backed out at a high rate of speed, spun their tires, and backed into Unit 2.

Driver of Unit 1 then put the car in "Drive" and accelerated forward making contact with Unit 3 which caused Unit 3 to crash into Unit 4. The momentum of the collision caused Unit 4 to crash into Unit 5.

The driver of Unit 1 said she was backing out of the parking space and felt her vehicle make contact with Unit 2. Driver of Unit 1 said she was frazzled by the impact, her foot slipped off the brake and on to the gas and accelerated at a high rate of speed in to the other 3 vehicle.

According to witness, [REDACTED], he saw Unit 1 pinned up against Unit 2. He went over, placed the vehicle in to "Park," turned it off and helped the driver of Unit 1 out of the vehicle.

Unit 1 was towed by Kitsap Tow and sustained significant front-end damage.

Unit 2 sustained minor damage to the front, driver side bumper area.

Unit 3 was towed and sustained significant damage to the passenger rear wheel well area along with the back driver side bumper area.

Unit 4 sustained damage to the passenger side and driver side of the vehicle.

Unit 5 sustained damage to the passenger side of the vehicle.
