

NARRATIVE

On 4-25-2024 at approximately 0934 hours I was dispatched to a non-injury 2 vehicle collision on State Highway 305 south of NE Seabold Church Rd.

I arrived on scene with Officer Buonvino #811 where a Washington State Patrol trooper was already on scene obtaining both driver's information. I pulled behind both vehicles and observed vehicle 1, a red 2004 Nissan Xterra bearing WA plate: [REDACTED], parked on the shoulder of State Highway 305 facing southbound.

Vehicle 2 was in front of vehicle 1 also facing southbound, a bronze 2019 Subaru Forrester bearing WA plate: [REDACTED].

Vehicle 1 had severe front end damage and was not driveable, the driver called for a tow during our investigation. Vehicle 2 had rear end damage. Both vehicle met the damage threshold. The on scene trooper provided me with both driver's license, insurance and registration information. Officer Buonvino took photographs of both vehicles which were later uploaded to evidence.com.

I spoke with the driver of vehicle 2 identified as [REDACTED] via his WA state driver's license. [REDACTED] advised that traffic was backed up and had come to a stop while he was traveling southbound on State Highway 305. He stated that his vehicle was stopped when vehicle 1 struck the rear of his vehicle.

I then spoke with the driver of vehicle 1 identified as [REDACTED] via her WA state driver's license [REDACTED] advised that she was also traveling southbound on State Highway 305 before running into the rear of vehicle 2. I asked her how fast she was going, she stated probably 20 miles per hour. She noted that she was paying attention and could see that traffic was coming to a stop. She stated that when she tried coming to a stop, her brakes locked up on her.
