

NARRATIVE

Driver of V1 called 911 when driver of V2 left the collision scene without providing anything other than first name () and phone number (), after arguing over who was at fault. Driver of V1 said driver of V2 smelled like he'd had alcohol.

V1 was southbound, nearing 7349 Madrona Dr. NE at about 25mph. V2 was northbound. The driver of V1 said V2 appeared to be going well over the speed limit. V1's driver said he tried to move as far right as possible. As the two passed, the front left corner of V2 struck the cargo box of V1, leaving scrapes, before striking the left rear hubcap of V1. V1's box did not have obvious denting; only scrapes. Where the hubcap protrudes (center) was obviously damaged. The driver of V1 stated he had not moved his car further to the right since impact. Where V1 was stopped left plenty of room for another vehicle to pass in the opposing direction. However, as the driver of V2 had left, I could not verify with him if that's how much room there was at the time of the collision.

Driver of V2 was contacted at his residence later this evening. He said he stopped, provided information to V1, and left. He believed he provided insurance information, but he wasn't certain. He said he was upset about personal issues, taking a new route home, and was struck by V1, who was not far enough to the southbound side of the road. Driver of V2 said he was only driving about 25mph. V2 had damage from front to rear, along the driver side. V1 only had damage starting along the cargo box.
