

NARRATIVE

On January 17 of 2024, I met with reporting party [REDACTED] who was an office administrator for the salon at building at 553 Madison Ave. The owner of the property was [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] informed me that, overnight on approximately January 6 or 7 of 2024, an unidentified vehicle drove off of the roadway at the Madison Ave / Wyatt Way roundabout and struck the gazebo on [REDACTED]'s property. I inspected the scene and saw clear tire tracks leading from the northwest corner of the roundabout, onto the lawn of 553 Madison, and through half of the gazebo approximately 15 feet from the roadway. Approximately half of the gazebo was knocked over and destroyed. The rest of the structure was still standing. I observed plants that were pulled up from around the gazebo back towards the roadway and no other tire tracks suggesting that the suspect vehicle backed out the same way they entered the lawn and fled the scene. I did not locate any evidence at the scene that could help identify the suspect or their vehicle. The attached diagram is an estimation of how the collision occurred based on my observations at the scene.
