

## NARRATIVE

On 07/04/2024, at approximately 1445 hours, I was dispatched by CENCOM to Wyatt Way NE / Madison Ave N regarding a single motor vehicle collision.

Upon arrival, I located a [REDACTED] bus stuck on a utility pole. I contacted the driver of the bus identified as [REDACTED] and his passengers. All parties involved stated they did not have any injuries and declined any medical attention.

[REDACTED] (Driver 1) stated he was driving westbound on Wyatt Way NE from Ericksen Ave NE. Driver 1 stated when approaching Madison Ave N, he noticed the roadway was blocked with a road closed sign, and he stopped his vehicle in the roadway by 490 Wyatt Way NE. Driver 1 stated he needed to turn his bus around to go back eastbound on Wyatt Way NE. Driver 1 stated he used the driveway of 490 Wyatt Way NE to back his bus into to turn it around and go back eastbound on Wyatt Way NE. Driver 1 stated he cut his turn to sharp and impelled a metal bracket from the utility pole into the back passenger window of the bus causing damage. I provided Driver 1 my business card with the case number.

Pictures of the utility pole and the [REDACTED] bus damages were taken and later uploaded into Evidence.com. Officers assisted Driver 1 get his vehicle off the metal bracket. Both passengers were picked up by another employee from [REDACTED]. The bus had a broken window and the utility pole had a bent approximately 4" x 4" metal bracket. I notified Puget Sound Energy (PSE) about the damage to the pole and they stated they will send someone out to look at the utility pole. I provided the case number and the pictures of the utility pole damages to PSE.
