

NARRATIVE

On 7-7-2024 at approximately 0930 hours I was dispatched to a single vehicle collisions at State Highway 305 and NE Seabold Rd. Bainbridge Island Fire Department Ambulance 21 advised that they were already on scene investigating and the driver was not injured.

I arrived on scene with Corporal Kazer #808 and contacted the driver identified as [REDACTED] via her WA State Driver's License. The vehicle (Vehicle 1) was parked on the southbound shoulder of State Highway 305 facing southbound. Vehicle 1 was a white 2014 Chevrolet Sonic bearing WA plate: [REDACTED] with a registered owner of [REDACTED]. Vehicle 1 had a decal on the side doors for [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was also in uniform for the same company and advised it is a company vehicle and she was currently working and had notified her supervisor of the collision.

Vehicle 1 had damage to the front driver's side wheel well and had a flat tire. Photographs were taken of the damage and later uploaded to evidence.com. I asked [REDACTED] to explain what happened. [REDACTED] stated that she was traveling southbound on State Highway 305 through the roundabout at NE Seabold Rd. As she was exiting the roundabout she stated that she got too close to the concrete jersey barrier and clipped it. She noted that this startled her.

Corporal Kazer and I asked if she was trying to avoid the protruding drain on the opposite side of the road by chance, she stated that she thought that may have been a factor.

Corporal Kazer checked the barrier and advised that there was no damage to it, photographs were also taken of the barrier.

[REDACTED] advised that she had a friend in route to assist her with changing the front driver's side tire. Her vehicle was parked safely off the roadway, we cleared the scene shortly after.
