

NARRATIVE

On 7-9-2024 I was dispatched to a single vehicle in a ditch at NE Koura Rd and State Highway 305. CENCOM advised that Bainbridge Island Fire Department was on scene and that the female driver had extricated herself. The female driver later identified as [REDACTED] was not injured. [REDACTED] was identified via her WA State Driver's license.

I arrived on scene with Sgt. Fastaia #803, I observed the vehicle, a white 2001 Toyota Tundra bearing WA plate: [REDACTED] (vehicle 1). Vehicle 1 was in the ditch at the southwest corner of the intersection at NE Koura Rd and State Highway 305 facing a southwest bound direction into a tree. Photographs were taken and later uploaded to evidence.com.

I contacted [REDACTED] who stated that the vehicle belongs to her father [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] explained that she was traveling southbound on State Highway 305 and was attempting to turn right onto NE Koura RD. She noted that she has never driven this truck before and was not used to how it handled.

[REDACTED] stated that when she slowed down to make the turn she lost control and began to slide. She stated that she tried to brake but just went straight into the ditch. [REDACTED] stated that she had called [REDACTED] regarding the situation and that [REDACTED] told her he was not sure if the vehicle was insured.
