

## NARRATIVE

On 07/28/2024, at approximately 0932 hours, I was dispatched by CENCOM to 220 Parfitt Way SW ([REDACTED]) parking lot regarding a motor vehicle collision.

Upon arrival, the vehicle was stuck over an approximately 3' embankment, and there was a passenger inside the vehicle that could not get out on her own. The Bainbridge Island Fire Department arrived with police and began to work on getting the passenger out of the vehicle.

Driver 1 stated she had just got back from picking her sister up (passenger) and was attempting to park her vehicle in a parking stall. Driver 1 stated the medical boot that she wears on her left leg got stuck under the pedal, she could not get the vehicle to stop, jumped the curb, and accelerated over the edge of the embankment. Driver 1 stated she did not sustain any injuries. Driver 1 stated she could not get the passenger out of the vehicle and so she waited for first responders to arrive. Driver 1 stated the vehicle is not hers and provided me with the contact information for the registered owner of the vehicle.

The passenger is Driver 1's older sister. The passenger has alzheimers and Driver 1 has power of attorney of passenger. Passenger was transported to ST. Michael Medical Center for complaint of dizziness and rib pain. Driver 1 was provided my business card with the case number and she left with a friend to go be with the passenger at the hospital.

I contacted the registered owner who stated he allowed Driver 1 to use his car while he was out of town. The owner called Kitsap Towing to have his vehicle winched off the embankment and parked in the parking lot. I provided the owner of the vehicle my business card with the case number.

I contacted the property owners of the embankment. I first contacted [REDACTED] and spoke with manager [REDACTED] about the damages to the plants and small trees. [REDACTED] stated the business was not concerned about the damages as they were going to have the plants and trees removed anyways. I contacted [REDACTED] and spoke with manager [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated she did not see any damages to her side of the property and stated they would not be seeking any reimbursement from the registered owner of the vehicle. I provided both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] my business card with the case number.
