

NARRATIVE

At the date and time indicated in this report I was dispatched by CENCOM for a collision at the intersection of State Hwy 305/ Day Rd with unknown injuries that had been onviewed by Engine-22 (E-22) of the Bainbridge Island Fire Department. I responded code to the scene and discovered that there had been no injuries and that E-22 had stopped traffic to allow for investigation of the scene.

I interviewed the drivers of all three involved vehicles and asked them to move to the Day Road Park and Ride so that I could open the road, to which all drivers acknowledged. After conclusion of my investigation it was determined that the driver of Vehicle 1 () had not been paying attention and was following Vehicle 2 () too closely. Vehicle 2 had come to a stop behind Vehicle 3 () which had been stopped at the red traffic signal at the intersection of State Hwy 305/ Day Rd.

Vehicle 1 ran into the rear end of Vehicle 2, which was pushed into the rear end of Vehicle 3 as a result. The driver of Vehicle 1 () was honest and forthcoming with the fact that he had run into the back of Vehicle 2 and had caused the subsequent collisions. () was cited for following too closely and all vehicles were able to drive away from the scene.
