

## NARRATIVE

On 03-23-2024 VEH 2 was legally parked and unoccupied in space #14 at the diamond parking lot at the Bainbridge Island ferry terminal at approximately 1500 hours. The witness observed VEH 1 attempt to pull into spot #13, crash into the front driver's side bumper of VEH 2, back up, and then drive away without leaving information behind. The witness provided a possible plate for VEH 1, that I later determined to belong to a vehicle that was not involved in a collision. The witness either provided the wrong plate, or confused VEH 1 with another vehicle, and provided that plate.

VEH 2 sustained significant damage to the bumper, headlight assembly, and driver's fender area above the reportable threshold.

The witness was the initial 911 caller, and officers at that time could not locate the owner of VEH 2.

VEH 2 called 911 on 03-24-2024 to report the collision again. DRV 2 supplied pictures of his vehicle I have uploaded to Evidence.com.

The plate provided by the witness came back to a local address on Bainbridge Island, and I located a vehicle with that plate affixed. The vehicle the plate was on did not have corresponding damage, and the witness advised it would have significant damage. The witness also stated the driver of VEH 1 (the running vehicle) was a male with short dark hair. The address I checked on Bainbridge Island did not have any residents matching that description.
