

NARRATIVE

At the date and time indicated in this report I was dispatched by CENCOM for a report of an unknown injury collision of a driver into a telephone pole near the intersection of Sunrise Dr and Winther Rd. I responded to the scene and discovered a Blue Xterra (Vehicle 1) that had collided with both a telephone pole and adjacent mailbox belonging to the residents of 11752 Sunrise Dr.

The front airbag of the Xterra had deployed but the driver, [REDACTED], declined medical attention. [REDACTED] had made mention of feeling minor pain in her wrists and hands from the deployment of the front airbag, but again declined aid. [REDACTED] explained to me that she had been driving northbound on Sunrise Dr and was looking at the flowers and accidentally drifted over and struck the utility pole and mailbox before coming to a stop on the shoulder immediately north of the utility pole. The residents of 11752 had heard the collision from inside and had come out to call 911.

The damage to the front passenger side of the vehicle was consistent with the explanation of events that had occurred and all parties exchanged information without incident. There was noticeable damage to the mailbox and utility pole. Puget Sound Energy was dispatched to assess damages to the utility pole and advised that it will likely need to be replaced. PSE driver [REDACTED] was provided with the case number and insurance information for the driver of Vehicle 1 as well. Vehicle 1 was towed from the scene to a location chosen by the owner.
