Unit # 2 was parked at the Bainbridge Island Library, not in a space, but against a curb and not

contrary to any posted sign. Unit #2 driver reported that she pulled into the disabled spot in front of #2, but realized that she didn't have her disabled placard and backed out. She believed that she hit a curb, but the witness and the owner of unit #2 advised that the front driver side of her vehicle struck the passenger door of Unit #2, causing a significant crease. Driver of #1 advised that she then parked in a non-disabled space in the same lot, which was corroborated by the witness. Driver of #1 left the lot and owner of #2 got in his vehicle and followed her to obtain a license plate. Based on the plate, the owner was contacted and advised that his mother was driving. When speaking with the officer, she advised she didn't feel that she hit another vehicle, and she and her son checked the vehicle and were unable to see any damage. Officer did not respond to examine the vehicle for damage.
