

NARRATIVE

On 5-28-2024 at approximately 0753 hours I was dispatched to a non-injury, non-blocking motor vehicle collision at the intersection of Blakely Ave NE and NE Baker Hill Rd involving a charcoal Audi that had rear ended a burgundy Subaru.

I arrived on scene and observed vehicle one, a grey 2018 Audi A4 Allroad bearing WA plate: [REDACTED], pulled onto the shoulder of Blakely Ave NE facing north bound and parked in front of vehicle two. Vehicle one had front end damage to the grill and hood.

Vehicle two was a burgundy 2016 Subaru Crosstrek bearing WA plate: [REDACTED] also parked on the shoulder of Blakely Ave NE facing northbound. Vehicle two had damage to the rear bumper.

I spoke with the driver of vehicle two identified as [REDACTED] via her WA State driver's license. [REDACTED] explained that she was traveling northbound on Blakely Ave NE and came into the school zone, she noted that it was busy due to people trying to get into the school at Blakely Elementary which is across from where this intersection is located

She stated that she stopped at the intersection so that a vehicle could pull out to turn left off Ne Baker Hill Rd due to how busy the traffic was from the school. She stated that she had to stop again when another car pulled in front of her also off NE Baker Hill Rd requiring her to stop again. When she topped vehicle one hit the rear of her vehicle.

I then spoke with the driver of vehicle one identified as [REDACTED] via his WA State driver's license. [REDACTED] also noted that he was traveling northbound on Blakely Ave NE and that vehicle two had randomly stopped in front of him. He stated that his vehicle's "auto pilot" was on, but it did not stop. I asked [REDACTED] how fast he thought he was going, he stated that he did not know. I asked how far behind he was from vehicle two, he estimated the length that the vehicles were currently at parked between the two. I estimated it was roughly 8 to 9 feet.
