On May 31 2024, at approximately 12:30 hours, Bainbridge Island Police Department building when executive administrative assistant informed me that there was a two car collision in the intersection of Madison Ave. and new Brooklyn. I responded to that intersection in my

patrol vehicle and discovered the two vehicles partially blocking the intersection. Fire was on scene and found that no one was injured during the collision. I observed that vehicle #2, a black work van, and had both side airbags deployed. There was extensive damage the passenger side of the van. Next observed a red Jeep that was on new

Brooklyn just West of the intersection with danger site grill and bomber. I identified the drivers of both vehicles and we agreed to move out of the intersection and up into a nearby parking lot. Witness information was consistent with what both drivers told me, that the van was southbound on Madison when the Jeep entered the intersection and struck the van on the passenger side. Once we arrived in the nearby parking lot gathered the information from both parties and the driver of the Jeep, vehicle #1, said that she had gone through the stop sign and impacted the van. The Jeep the right people from enterprise rental. While the driver could not provide me any insurance information for the enterprise car she did provide me her own her own insurance information from USAA.

Both parties were given the case number to this incident and were referred to their respective

insurance carriers.
