On 10/31/2024, at approximately 1803 hours, I was dispatched by CENCOM to SR 305 / NE West

Port Madison RD regarding a single motor vehicle collision. (Driver 1)

reported his vehicle is a rental, it is disabled, he was not injured, and is not blocking the roadway. I contacted Driver 1 (D1). D1 stated he was traveling approximately 35 miles per hour southbound on SR 305 and approaching the roundabout at NE West Port Madison RD when a deer ran in front of his vehicle. D1 stated the deer was crossing SR 305 from East to West. D1 stated he was not able to

get his vehicle stopped before colliding with the deer. D1 stated the deer continued westbound

across SR 305 into the woods. D1 stated he continued to drive through the roundabout to find a safe place to pull over. D1 stated he got out to inspect the vehicle and noticed it was leaking coolant. D1 stated he contacted (National) the vehicle rental company's afterhours number and they requested him to contact local police for a report. D1 stated his rental company is sending a tow and he was instructed to stay with the vehicle.

I took pictures of the damages to D1's vehicle and later submitted them into Evidence.com. The

vehicle appeared to have reportable damage to the front bumper and was leaking coolant from the engine compartment. I provided D1 with an exchange of information and my business card with the case number.
