## Drivers of both vehicles agreed on the sequence of events leading to this collision. Both were

of Unit #1. Both reported that a construction vehicle working on a multi-family housing project on the northeast corner of the intersection of Wyatt Way and Madison Avenue entered the roadway and occluded the westbound lane in front of and to the left (north) of both units. This would not have presented an issue, but parties reported that a Jeep vehicle traveling west on Wyatt Way drove around the construction equipment and into the eastbound lane, causing the driver of Unit #2 to come to an abrupt stop to avoid a collision. The driver of Unit #1 reported looking right as he completed navigating the roundabout, and did not see Unit #2 stopped in the roadway, and struck the rear of it

eastbound on Wyatt Way, having just come through the roundabout at Madison, with Unit #2 ahead

to an abrupt stop to avoid a collision. The driver of Unit #1 reported looking right as he completed navigating the roundabout, and did not see Unit #2 stopped in the roadway, and struck the rear of it with the front of his vehicle. No further information on the Jeep vehicle, reportable damage to both units. Unit #2 advised her insurance was the same as on her card but was unable to provide a current card.
