## NARRATIVE

Bayhill RD regarding a single vehicle collision. CENCOM advised the driver was slumped over in the front passenger seat convulsing and possibly having a seizure.

Upon arrival, the Bainbridge Island Fire Department (BIFD) was on scene, and administering medical

On 08/14/2024, at approximately 1953 hours, I was dispatched by CENCOM to Miller RD NE / NE

care to the driver. BIFD stated the driver was ok and is undergoing a medical evaluation in the Aid car. BIFD stated the driver was recently diagnosed with having seizures and this is possibly his second one. BIFD stated they will not need to transport the driver to the hospital and that he will need approximately 30 minutes to recover. BIFD attended to the driver inside their Aid car. BIFD contacted the driver's parents and stated they will be on their way to our location.

Driver 1's vehicle was resting on a support cable to a telephone pole. There appeared to be no damages to the support cable or the telephone pole. BIFD backed Driver 1's vehicle off the support cable and parked it in the nearby driveway. Driver 1's vehicle had front bumper damage where the vehicle hit the support cable. Pictures of the vehicle were taken before and after it was moved and later uploaded into Evidence.com.

I spoke with Driver 1. Driver 1 stated he was southbound on Miller RD NE heading home from work. Driver 1 stated he last remembered feeling weird and suspected he was going to have a second seizure. Driver 1 stated he pulled his vehicle over and laid on his side as instructed by the doctor to prepare for the seizure. Driver 1 stated he then only remembers waking up to being surrounded by first responders.

Driver 1's parents arrived on scene. I advised them on their son's condition and the incident. I advised them to work with Driver 1 on making sure his insurance is current and his driver license status. Parents stated one of them would drive their son home who lives with them and the other would take Driver 1's vehicle home.
