

NARRATIVE

On 8-25-2024 at approximately 1656 hours I was dispatched to a non-injury motor vehicle collision at State Highway 305 near Winslow Way E.

I arrived on scene and observed vehicle 1, a white 2016 Acura ILX bearing WA plate: [REDACTED], pulled over on the shoulder of State Highway 305, roughly 50-75 feet north of the intersection at Winslow Way E. Vehicle 2, a dark grey 2020 BMW X 4 bearing WA plate: [REDACTED], was parked directly in front of vehicle 1.

Both vehicles were facing southbound towards the intersection. Traffic was heavy at this location due to the ferry line. Vehicle 1 had reportable damage to the front bumper, while vehicle 2 had reportable damage to the rear bumper. Both vehicles were still drivable. Photographs were taken and uploaded to evidence.com. Upon arrival both parties stated no one was injured.

I initially spoke with the driver of vehicle 2, [REDACTED] identified via his WA State Driver's license. [REDACTED] advised that he was traveling southbound on State Highway 305 in the right lane (ferry line lane) and was slowing down to come to a stop for the red light at Winslow Way E. [REDACTED] stated that he observed vehicle 1 cutting in the ferry line before rear ending him.

I then spoke with the driver of vehicle 1, [REDACTED] identified via her WA State Driver's license. [REDACTED] stated that she was also traveling southbound on State Highway 305 in the center lane trying to get over in the ferry line. She noted that she was eventually let in and while getting over she hit the rear of vehicle 2. [REDACTED] noted that vehicle 2 appeared to have stopped suddenly. I asked [REDACTED] if she could see if the light was red, she stated yes, but noted that she did not think there were any other vehicles in front of vehicle 2. [REDACTED]'s passenger [REDACTED] noted that she did not believe the light was red.

I advised [REDACTED] she would be mailed a notice of infraction for following too closely, ticket #: [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that she understood and confirmed her current address.

Both parties were provided the case number and exchange of information documents. When speaking with [REDACTED] and his passenger [REDACTED], they both noted that they're necks and shoulders were sore after. They both declined AID.
